- iv) The widowed, divorced or separated mother of an ex-service son or daughter who died in action, or who is totally and permanently disabled.

- i) Active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States, in a war, or during the period 4/28/52-7/1/55.
- ii) Active duty for more that 180 consecutive days other than for training, any part of which occurred during the period beginning 2/1/55-10/14/76.
- iii) During the Gulf War from August 2, 1990, through January 2, 2000
- iv) Active duty in a campaign or expedition for which a campaign badge has been authorized
